## GLENDOWER Magoebaskloof BIRDS & FORESTS FESTIVAL 13 – 15 November 2009

THE MAGOEBAKLOOF FORESTS offer arguably the best forest birding in the country. The Capricorn-Letaba Birding Route, in association with Glendower, will be hosting the fourth Birds and Forests Festival. The festival will celebrate the rich biodiversity of these forests, there will be lectures given by specialists on a variety of topics such as forest birds, bird conservation and bird communication as well as outings to explore the birds, trees, mammals, butterflies and reptiles of the forests in the area. Participants will have the opportunity to explore the Afromontane forest of Woodbush and Black Forest as well as the riverine forests at Debengeni Falls and the upper Letaba. Local bird guides and birders will accompany all the outings to ensure that no birds are overlooked. The exciting programme allows participants to experience the biodiversity of the beautiful forests of Magoebaskloof while catching glimpses of specials such as Black-fronted Bush-Shrike, Cape Parrot, Bat Hawk and Green Twinspot.

Visitors can look forward to spending the weekend with various experts including Mark Anderson, Andre Botha, Derek Solomon, Geoff Lockwood and David Letsoalo.
