LIMPOPO HERITAGE DESTINATIONS 4NIGHTS/5DAYS

CODE: LHD

- DAY 1: Depart OR Tambo International Airport and drive to Waterberg, visit Nylsvlei which is the wetland of international significance in terms of the Ramsar Conservation and considered one of the top birding sites in Southern Africa boasting species list of approximately 400 birds. Dinner and overnight at a lodge
- DAY 2: Enjoy morning game viewing. After breakfast proceeds to Capricorn District via Mokopane. Guided tour at Arend Dieperenk the museum with the focus on the history of Potgietersrus and surroundings (the pioneer in the former Northern Transvaal as well as agricultural objects).
- Lunch at a restaurant in Mokopane. Enter Mokopane Nature Reserve for a tour. Depart Mokopane and travel to Polokwane and view lions at the Ranch Game Park.
- Check in at the lodge, refresh and relax. Afternoon game viewing at Polokwane Game Reserve. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.
- DAY 3: After breakfast, a visit to Polokwane Civic Center and the Irish House Museum. Then travel to Bakone Malapa Open-Air Museum.
- Enjoy the Magoebaskloof scenic drive on the way Modjadji Royal Kraal via Limpopo University and the ZCC Church.
- Learn about the dynasty of the Rain Queen. View the tallest cycad trees in the world at Modjadji Cycad Reserve and also view the African Ivory Route camp and the Sunland baobab tree (This baobab tree has a bar inside that can take up to 10 people inside)
- Lunch at Tzaneen and proceed to Phalaborwa. Visit Amarula Lapa, the home of Amarula Liquor. Visit Phalaborwa Mining Company to view the widest open cast mine considered to be the widest man made hole in Africa.
- Experience an exciting spotlight safari during evening game drive in the Kruger National Park dinner in the park (Bush Braai) and overnight at Boikhutsong.
- DAY 4: Morning walk, armed and experienced nature guide will introduce you to a number of skills, including tracking, plants, birds, animal behavior as well as identification and also have bush breakfast while viewing wildlife roaming freely in the park.
- Afternoon game drive followed by lunch at Olifants Camp at restaurant overlooking the Olifants River.
- Dinner and overnight at Satara camp.
- DAY 5: Morning game drives and exit KNP through Orpen Gate

DAY 1: Take a guided walk at the Civic Centre and learn more about the history/the development of Petersburg now known as Polokwane (The capital city of Limpopo)

Visit Bakone Malapa open air museum and explore the living culture of the Northern Sotho Culture of the Bakone people.

On our way to Polokwane Bird Sanctuary where you will experience the night life of birds in Polokwane we travel via Virgin Active & Peter Mokaba Stadium.

An afternoon shebeen tour in Seshego Township. This tour offers an orientation of the townships, unpacking the diversity of the areas and explains the origin and transformation of the townships. Drink and mingle with the locals at a local tavern discovering more about their township life.

Dinner at a local Shebeen bar. Overnight at an accredited accommodation in Polokwane town.

DAY 2: Early morning excursions at Polokwane Game Reserve. This offers visitors the best chance of spotting variety of game.

Proceed to Magoebaskloof via Moria (Headquarters of Zion Christian Church). Visit Debengeni Waterfalls believed by locals to be inhabited by water spirits. Drive to Coach House Hotel for overnight accommodation via the Sepekoe Tea Estate.

DAY 3: A drive to Sunland baobab tree (This baobab tree has a bar inside that can take up to 10 people inside).

Proceeds to Phalaborwa (The town of two summers) for lunch at Boikhotsong Guesthouse) Visit the home of Amarula Liquor. Evening game drive in the Kruger National Park followed by Dinner (Bushbraai). Overnight at Boikhutsong Guest House.

DAY 4: Morning walk in the Kruger National Park followed by bush breakfast. Afternoon drive in the park and lunch at Satara camp.

Exit at Orpen gate and fly back to OR Tambo from Hoedspruit Airport.

LIMPOPO CULTURAL DESTINATIONS 2NIGHTS/3DAY CODE: CD02

DAY 1: Take a guided walk at the Civic Centre and learn more about the history/the development of Petersburg now known as Polokwane (The capital city of Limpopo)

Visit Bakone Malapa open air museum and explore the living culture of the Northern Sotho Culture of the Bakone people.

Proceed to Magoebaskloof via Moria (Headquarters of Zion Christian Church). Visit Debengeni Waterfalls believed by locals to be inhabited by water spirits. Drive to Coach House Hotel for overnight accommodation via the Sepekoe Tea Estate.

DAY 2: A morning drive to the domain of the legendary and mystified Modjadji Kraal and view Modjadji (Encephalitis Transvenosus) protected for three centuries in the Royal Gardens.

After lunch we depart Modjadji and travel to Elim to visit Ha Mashamba Potters and Tsonga Textiles near Elim. While Elim listen to stories about well known characters like Breaker Morant and Trooper Eagle. From Elim the road takes us to Levubu at the foot of the Soutpansberg Mountains. Dinner and overnight at Tusk Hotel in Thohoyandou.

DAY 3: After breakfast we travel back to Polokwane. We'll also take a look at the cultivation of bananas and macadamias. Fly back to OR Tambo from Polokwane International Airport.



DAY 1: Meet with your guide in the morning at Polokwane International airport. Proceed to your accredited hotel for check in, refresh and relax at the hotel.

After lunch we take a tour to Bakone Malapa Open Air Museum. The museum links archeological site of the 17th century complex store wall and depicts the traditional ways of the Sotho people.

Afternoon game drive at Polokwane Game Reserve. The reserve is the home to the rare white rhino and many other game species. Dinner and overnight at the hotel

DAY 2: After breakfast we take a walk at the Civic Square and visit the Irish House and Hugh Exton Photographic Museum, the museum showcases the history of the people and the city through the lens of Exton glass-plate cameras.

Visit Gemco-Art Gallery which was established in 1975 to support manufacturers, wholesalers and retailers selling a wide range of curios ethnic art.

View the lions at the Ranch Hotel and enjoy lunch at Meropa Casino.

Bird viewing at Polokwane Bird Sanctuary where you will experience many species of birds that attracts tourists.

Seshego township tour. Drink and mingle with the local at the shebeen, discovering more about the township life. Dinner and overnight at a hotel.

DAY 3: Explore the city of Makhado one of the great Va-venda's legend. Visit Schoemansdal Environmental Center at Makhado. Explore walking through Hendrick Vervoed Tunnel, one of the few tunnels in Africa.

A drive to the "BIG TREE" a baobab tree that dates back hundreds of years with a stem which can take a human chain of 20 people around its circumstances.

Check in at Eclipse Safari Lodge. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: Morning game drive at Eclipse Safari lodge. Visit Mphephu Holiday Resort a fun filled Spa resort set on the hillside of the banks of Ndzelele River.

Drive to the local village and witness crafters natural talent wood and stone curving

Drive through Mapungubwe National Park World Heritage Site. Overnight at one of the camps in Mapungubwe

DAY 5: Visit Makapans Valley Caves, Mokopane Nature Reserve and Arend Dieperink Museum which with the focus on the history of Potgietersrus and surrounds (the pioneer in the former Northern Transvaal as well as agricultural objects).

Check in at the lodge. Dinner and overnight

After breakfast we travel to OR Tambo International Airport for drop off.

BEST OF THE TWO PROVINCES 3NIGHTS/4DAYS**CODE:BTP**

DAY 1: Fly from OR Tambo International Airport to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Meet your tour guide. Lunch at Hazyview and head to a panoramic route and have the opportunity to visit Graskop, Gods window, the potholes, Blyde River Canyon, Pinnacle Rock.

Dinner and overnight at Pilgrims Rest.

DAY 2: After breakfast a drive to Sabie Forestry Museum. Visit Shangaan Cultural Village and experience the history of the shangaan people.

Day drive at Kapama Game Reserve – Sit back and relax on an open vehicle game drive through the Breeding & Research Station visit. Get an opportunity to touch one of the big cats or have a vulture on your arm at Moholoholo Rehabilitation Centre. Dinner and overnight at Kapama.

DAY 3: Enter Kruger National Park through Orpen Gate and enjoy an exciting wilderness experience with Africa's big five. Lunch at Satara Camp Check inn at Letaba Camp for overnight accommodation, night drive and bush braai.

DAY 4: Morning walk in the Kruger National Park followed by bush breakfast. Exit the park through Phalaborwa gate via Masorini Heritage site and explore the preserved historic findings of the Iron Age people.

Visit the home of Amarula Liquor. Depart Phalaborwa and proceed to Efaf in Mooketsi for elephant back safari and witness close up the mystery and magic of the African Elephant. Under the guidance of the world recognized Elephant Trainers. Witness how they adapt and live.

Enjoy horse back safaris and quad biking at Thaba Metsi Adventures. Dinner at Magoebaskloof hotel and overnight.

After breakfast, proceed to Bakone Malapa Orpen air museum and visit Polokwane Bird Sanctuary where you will experience the night life of birds

Proceed back to Polokwane airport for a flight back to OR Tambo

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK FLY IN SAFARI 2NIGHTS/3DAYS CODE:KNPF

DAY 1: Arrive on board SA Airways at Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Shopping at Hazyview and enter the Kruger National Park through Kruger Gate.

Check inn at Skukuza Rest Camp, refresh and relax followed by lunch at Skukuza Restaurant

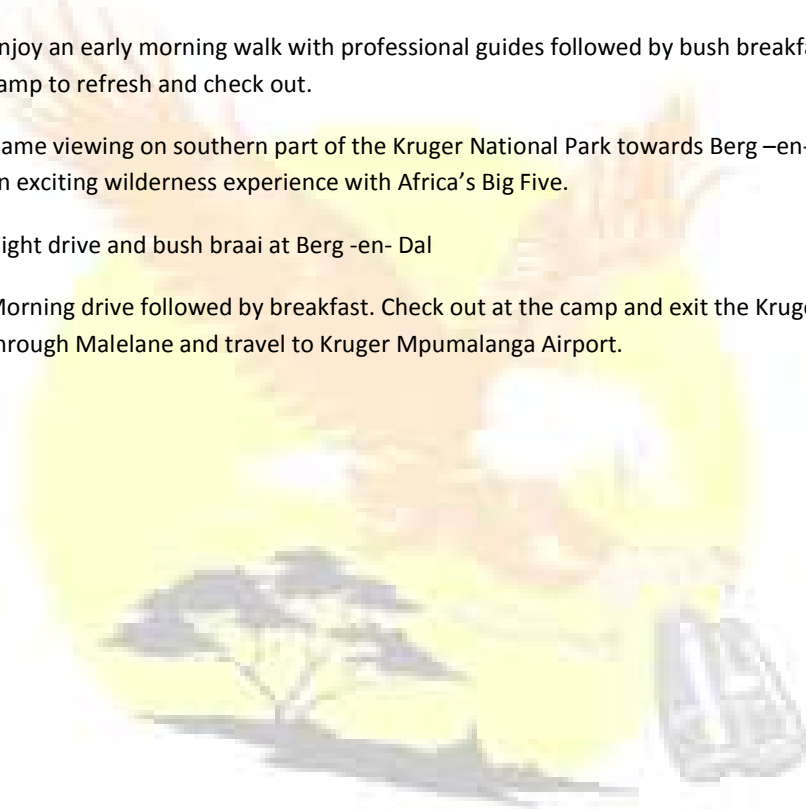
Evening game drive. Dinner and overnight

DAY 2: Enjoy an early morning walk with professional guides followed by bush breakfast. Return to the camp to refresh and check out.

Game viewing on southern part of the Kruger National Park towards Berg –en- Dal Rest Camp for an exciting wilderness experience with Africa’s Big Five.

Night drive and bush braai at Berg -en- Dal

DAY 3: Morning drive followed by breakfast. Check out at the camp and exit the Kruger National Park through Malelane and travel to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport.



BEST OF THE TWO WILDLIFE SAFARI FLY IN 2NIGHTS/3DAYS CODE: WSF

DAY 1: Arrive on board SA Airways at Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Meet your guide and enter the Kruger National Park through Phalaborwa Gate.

Travel to Letaba Rest Camp via Masorini Heritage site and explore the preserved historic findings of the Iron Age people.

Check inn at Letaba. Enjoy lunch at restaurant overlooking the river.

Game drive and bus braai and overnight at the camp

DAY 2: Morning walk followed by bush breakfast. Refresh and check out. Enjoy game viewing traveling towards central via Olifants Camp. Lunch at Satara Camp.

Exit Kruger National Park at Orpen Gate and travel to Kapama Game Reserve – visit Cheetah Breeding Center. Dinner and overnight at Kapama

DAY 3: Morning game walk followed by breakfast. Check out and travel to Hoedspruit Airport for a flight back to OR Tambo International Airport.



DAY 1: MANYELETI

From Gauteng the route leads east wards to Manyeleti Game Reserve through Mpumalanga. En route to Big Five country lies Drankensburg Escarpment, with its sheer rock wall, pockets of indigenous forest, grass covered mountains slopes and vast plantations. It abounds with streams, waterfalls, crystal-clear pools and potholes and embraces the world's third largest canyon-the Blyde River Canyon.

From the top of the escarpment, the route descends nearly a thousand meters to the low lying 23 000 hectares Manyeleti Game Reserve which shares an unfenced boundary with the adjacent Kruger National Park. The main attractions are guided walking trails and game drives from Ndzhaka tented safari camp or Buffelshoek trails camp in big five territory

DAY 2: MANYELETI

An early morning start means a walk can be enjoyed before breakfast. Activities of the day could include Moholoholo rehabilitation center or Kapama Cheetah Breeding project or a day drive in the Kruger National Park via Orpen gate or stay in Manyeleti and enjoy nature at its best or you may prefer an early transfer to the trails camp. Upon your return to the camp the night drive awaits you on an open vehicle where you will explore the nocturnal activities of the bush as interpreted and explained by the guides.

DAY 3: DRANKENSBURG EXPLORER

Westwards through the scenic Lekgalameetse Nature Reserve after the morning breakfast the journey leads on the Drankensburg escarpment en route to Mafefe. The scenic beauty of the area and the friendly faces of the local children compensate for extremely bumpy and dusty 4x4 track up the mountain to the Mafefe camp built in the Pedi style in honor of the legendary 19th century king Sekhukhune who refused to bow to Boer rulership.

DAY 4: HOMEWARD

Real 4x4 enthusiasts have option of a scenic, though rough, track from the camp towards the abandoned Penge mine from a good tarred road leads the way home via Burgersfort.

LIVING CULTURE & WILDLIFE DESTINATIONS 3NIGHTS/4DAYS CODE:LCWD

DAY 1: LEGENDARY RAIN QUEEN.

From Gauteng the route leads northwards to Bela-Bela along the Great North Route (N1) and then eastwards down to Kudu Valley to Duiwelskloof the domain of the legendary Rain Queen Modjadji of the Lobedu people. A walk through the cycad reserve provides insight into the cultural importance of the lobedu, the three century old dynasty of the Rain Queen and the botanical oddity that thrives here. Modjadji camp built in the traditional style of the lobedu is situated inside the reserve.

DAY 2: LETABA RANCH GAME RESERVE

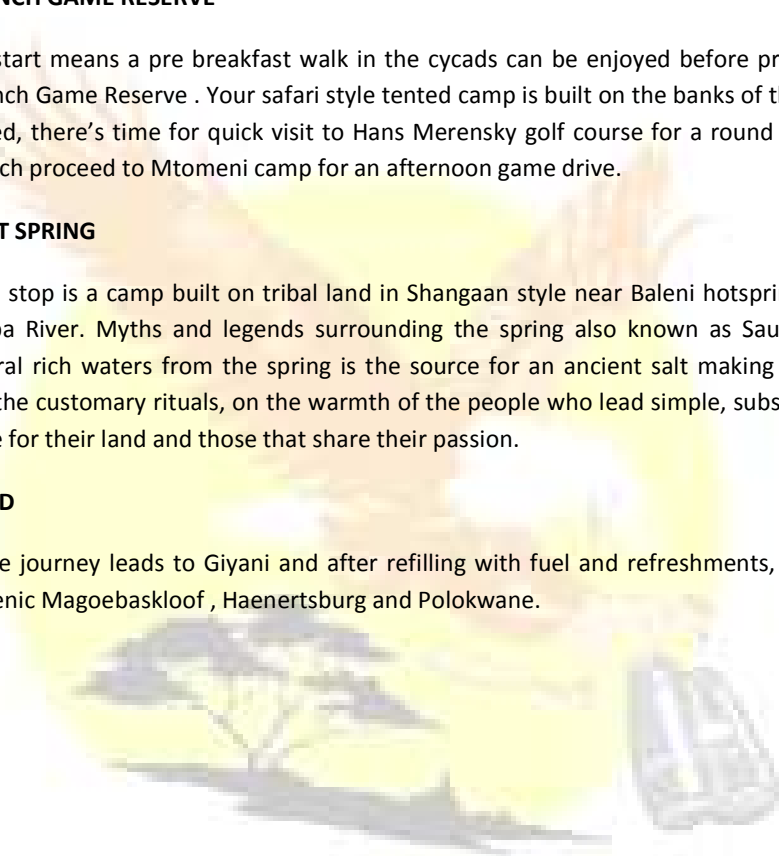
An early morning start means a pre breakfast walk in the cycads can be enjoyed before proceeding to Mtomeni camp in Letaba Ranch Game Reserve . Your safari style tented camp is built on the banks of the Great Letaba River. For those interested, there's time for quick visit to Hans Merensky golf course for a round with the wild animals watching. After lunch proceed to Mtomeni camp for an afternoon game drive.

DAY 3: BALANI HOT SPRING

The next overnight stop is a camp built on tribal land in Shangaan style near Baleni hot spring on the bank of the klein (little) Letaba River. Myths and legends surrounding the spring also known as Sautini, the place of salt abound. The mineral rich waters from the spring is the source for an ancient salt making process, which is still practiced, with all the customary rituals, on the warmth of the people who lead simple, subsistence lives and have a deep abiding love for their land and those that share their passion.

DAY 4: HOMEWARD

After breakfast the journey leads to Giyani and after refilling with fuel and refreshments, the road takes us to Gauteng via the scenic Magoebaskloof , Haenertsburg and Polokwane.



DAY 1: NTUBU CAMP

Masebe Nature Reserve

From Gauteng the route leads northwards to Bela-Bela along the Great North Route (N1) and the northwards via scenic Waterberg to Ntubu safari camp. The area offers a fascinating excursion into local archaeology, history and excellent birding opportunities.

The dramatic scenery of the Waterberg escarpment is not known to many

DAY 2: ROCK ART AT BAHANANWA

Day two's highlights include beautiful sandveld and surrealistic sandstone formations of the Makgabeng such as the new Jerusalem pinnacle rock of some 200 meters high. A rare sight. The region features many archeological sites with rock art of international importance at Bahananwa massive. Overnight in the scenic Blouberg camp.

DAY 3: BLOUBERG TRAILS CAMP

Today's excursions could include a visit to the Leipzig missionary station and a guided visit to various cultural attractions in Blouberg. Boshela River provides various pool for swimming. After lunch a guided trails leads to the top of the mountain. Overnight in the trails camp built on top of Blouberg.

DAY 4: TRAILS

Once the early morning mist has dissipated, the trail lead westward to the chief's kraal, on a circular route with dramatic scenery and opportunity for a unique cultural experience, including a visit to a traditional healer. The area is also home to one of the largest colonies of Cape vultures in South Africa as well as giant indigenous yellow wood trees. Overnight the trails camp once more.

DAY 5: HOME

Descend the mountain to base camp. Leaving the beauty and tranquility of Blouberg, the route leads to Gauteng via the Tropic of Capricorn and provincial capital (Pietersburg)
